## CLASSROOM VISITS ▼

Each year, AANM presents a variety of educational programs both in-person and online, reaching classrooms across the nation. These year-round programs include virtual live and guided tours, interactive activities for students, video and audio resources for the classroom, and more. ## ENGAGING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS ▲

The Museum presents various youth programs each year, such as the AANM Writing Fellowship, the Al-Hadiqa Garden Apprenticeship and Shababeek Culture Camp. These programs, with support from professional artists, guide middle and high school students in telling their stories through different artistic mediums. From writing and gardening to photography and performing, the Museum’s youth programs give students resources and support to explore their creative selves.



## TRAVELING EXHIBITIONS ▼

AANM exhibitions counter misconceptions and stereotypes about Arab Americans while illustrating the immigrant experience of diverse communities. The Museum launched “Arab Massachusetts: Building Community in the Commonwealth” in 2025 - an exhibit traveling across Massachusetts that uplifts Arab American voices, explores the layered tension between assimilation and the push to preserve one’s culture, and ultimately celebrates the ways Arab Americans have built and found strength in cross-cultural communities throughout time.



## INNOVATIVE ARTISTIC ENDEAVORS ▲

In 2025, AANM featured exciting solo exhibitions: “Seeing the Southend” by Tony Maine and “The Art of Spiritual Enlightenment” by Harout Bastajian. The breadth and variety of these artists reflects our intention to uplift, support and showcase diverse artists, while also archiving their work as part of the larger Arab American story.
